OBJECTIVE

For the recruitment process of health professionals from Mexico and Brazil and the related professional recognition procedure in Germany, extensive certified translations of the candidates' entire application documents from Spanish and Portuguese into German are required.

PROCESS

This process is handled by various institutions commissioned with the recruitment of foreign professionals, such as the Central Foreign and Specialist Placement Office (ZAV) of the Federal Employment Agency or the German Agency for Healthcare and Nursing Professions GmbH (DeFa), with whom Schneiders-Sprach-Service works closely in order to process the abundance of documents in as short a time as possible.

RESULT

By translating on time and in accordance with the requirements of the Berlin recognition authority, we make an important contribution to meeting the deadlines in the recognition process.

Due to the numerous translations of documents from various universities throughout the country, incomplete/incorrect documents are also identified in the translation process. Our partners are notified accordingly and can request corrected documents at short notice, thus minimising delays.
